# **Japan Invokes Special Safeguard for Cornstarch**

## **Report Highlights:**

On February 7, 2019, Japan notified the World Trade Organization that it was invoking a volume-based special safeguard on imports of cornstarch (HS code 110812) – see <u>G/AG/N/JPN/234</u>. Between April and December 2018, Japan imported 1,038 MT of cornstarch which exceeded its trigger level for implementation of a special safeguard. Accordingly, Japan is imposing additional duties (an additional one third of the normal duties) from February 1 to March 31, 2019.

### **General Information:**

On February 7, 2019, Japan notified the World Trade Organization that it was invoking a volume-based special safeguard on imports of cornstarch (HS code 110812) – see <u>G/AG/N/JPN/234</u> and Attachment 1. Between April and December 2018, Japan imported 1,038 MT of cornstarch which exceeded the 922.8 MT trigger level for implementation of a special safeguard (NOTE: the safeguard is triggered when imports exceed 125 percent of the average import volume of the last three years). Accordingly, Japan is imposing additional duties (an additional one third of the normal duties of 25 percent or 119 yen/kg) from February 1 to

March 31, 2019 (the remainder of the Japanese fiscal year<sup>1</sup>).

From April to December 2018, Japan imported 1,038 MT of cornstarch, including 42.2 percent (438 MT) from Australia, 32.3 percent (336 MT) from the Netherlands, and 9.6 percent (100 MT) from South Korea. Japan imported 29 MT from the United States, accounting for 2.8 percent of the import share during this period.

By HS code, 571 MT was imported outside of the WTO Pooled Duty-Free Quota<sup>2</sup> (HS110812090) and 427 MT and 40 MT were imported within the WTO Pooled Quota via HS110812020 and HS110812020,

respectively. In January 2019, only product from Australia and Italy (66 MT and 4 MT, respectively) was imported under HS110912099.

Despite their imports contributing to the safeguard trigger, the special safeguard does not apply to imports within the Tariff Rate Quota or to imports from Comprehensive and Progressive Agreement for Trans-Pacific Partnership (CPTPP) countries<sup>3</sup> or EU member states.

As domestic consumption is not taken into account, in accordance with paragraph 4 of Article 5 of the Agreement on Agriculture, the base trigger level is calculated as 125% of the three-year average imports.

In the relevant ministerial notification (Notification of the Ministry of Finance, No.91, 31 March 2018), trigger level of this product is described as 923 tonnes as a result of rounding to integer.
